EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

All dogs must be on a short leash and under control while on trial grounds except while showing. FLEXI LEASHES ARE NOT PERMITTED INSIDE ANY BUILDINGS.

Please pick up after your dog and dispose of waste in appropriate containers outside the building.

RUNNING ORDER:

Dogs will be run in height order with dogs being handled by the same person separated into different staged groups. The run order and further scheduling details will be e-mailed to all competitors after trial closes and the actual number of entries in each class is known. MASCUSA reserves the right to change run order based on entries.

Height Divisions: Small - Dogs 13" and under

Medium - Dogs 13.1 to 18" Large - Dogs over 18"

Please bring weather appropriate gear. These trials will be held outdoors. There will be crating space available under cover, or out of your vehicles Please make sure your crate is secure as the dogs may be highly excited.

Bitches in season are eligible for entry but will be required to be kept separate from all other dogs and will be run at the end of their class/trial.

Entry fees for bitches that come into season will be refunded until closing time of the trial if you wish to withdraw. After the trial closes, entry fees will not be refunded. If bringing a bitch in season, please inform the trial secretary prior to the trial and inform all exhibitors at the judge's briefing.

Please bring adequate water for you and your dogs. There will be a limited concession available on site and there are also numerous fast food restaurants within 5-10 minutes of the trial.

There will be Port-A-Johns also available. There are indoor restrooms in the Event Center up the hill and the Visitors Center. Both within walking distance.

Dog Aggression: Any dog behaving in a threatening or aggressive manner toward another dog or a person may be dismissed from the trial if justification is found to do so by the judge and/or trial committee.

Refunds: No refunds will be made after the entry deadline. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from the competition by action of the Event Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Volunteer Sign-Up Form

Gate Steward/ Staging Steward Responsible for calling the exhibitors into the blind, and are brought to the ring when the judge is ready. This is an important job that requires good concentration and people skills.
Timer – The judge may act as timer or designate someone else to time. This person is responsible for accurately timing each dog's run. This is an important job that requires concentration.
Course Builder—quickly and accurately moves bales of straw into different configurations to build and maintain the courses per judge's instructions
Trial Secretary helperAssists trial secretary with various duties.
Scribe Sheet Runner Brings Scribe sheets from the ring to the trial office/secretary.
Scribe Responsible for accurately recording the judge's calls for tunnels, climbs, and the final run time, etc. This is an important job that requires excellent concentration. The judge may or may not request a scribe.
Leash Runner – Accepts leash and collar from handler and places it near the exit. May also assist as sheet runner.
RatWrangler – responsible for rats and PVC tubes and able to ensure humane treatment of same. There should be two rat wranglers, one inside and the other outside the ring. Both work with the judge to remove and replace rats in a timely and efficient manner so as to facilitate efficient trial flow.
Hospitality – Greets attendees and exhibitors and directs them to trial office/secretary for sign in. Coordinates refreshments, if offered.

HOW TO WATCH A BARN HUNT

- 1. Try and watch through an entire group of 5 hunts. By arriving and leaving as the rat locations are changed, keeps disruption to a minimum.
- 2. Observe and admire the hunting, scenting, problem solving, and teamwork skills of the dogs and handlers.
- 3. Do not mention where the rats / tubes are hidden, either to another observer or competitor. You could be overheard by others.
- 4. Minimize conversation during the run. Once the run is over, feel free to cheer and congratulate or commiserate with the team.
- 5. If you see a dog eliminate on course and the judge/gate steward did not see it, wait until after the run to tell the gate steward, who will arrange for clean-up.
- 6. Other than elimination in the ring, if the judge did not see it, it did not happen. If the judge did not see the climb/tunnel or other non-qualifying behavior (patting bale, touching dog, etc.), it is not spectators / competitors responsibility to mention it.
- 7. Please give room to the outside rat wranglers removing tubes along the fence line.
- 8. All dogs must remain at least 20 feet from the ring.
- 9. No food or beverages allowed near the ring.
- 10. Let your dog relax in the crate or car while you are watching. You learn more without having to attend to your dog. Well-behaved, quiet dogs may be crated in the crating area.
- 11. You may video or photograph for personal use only, as long as you are not a distraction to the team; i.e., loud shutter noise, too close, or hanging over fencing, etc.
- 12. NO visiting the "Rat Rest Area" with or without a dog. Strictly enforced!
- 13. Children must be attended at all times, or will be fed to the rats.
- 14. This is a high-arousal sport! Be aware of your surroundings and dogs entering and leaving the ring.
- 15. HAVE FUN!!

AWARDS:

Rosettes will be awarded for first through fourth place in Novice, Open, Senior and Master classes in each height division.

Ribbons will be awarded for all qualifiers in the regular classes and the Instinct Test.

High in Class rosettes will be offered in Novice, Open, Senior and Master classes for each trial.

New Title rosettes will be awarded to all dogs earning a title

RATCH – rosettes will be ordered and mailed to the recipients after the trial.
